

BULBS FOR VALENTINE FORCING

To successfully grow flowerbulbs for pot or cut, a minimum of 14 weeks of cooling (45 - 48 F) is needed. "PRECOOLED" bulbs have been cooled for six weeks prior to shipping to customer. Upon arrival, customer needs to grow for three additional weeks at 55 - 58 F to initiate the root system. After root initiation, bring temperature down to 41 - 45 F and continue growing for another eight weeks, then bring into greenhouse and force at 65 F for approximately four weeks. Following are "Precooled" bulbs recommended for Valentine forcing:
